



TENNIS FLOODLIGHTS - BYE-LAWS

1. Booking of hard courts applies only to the evenings in the winter season when floodlights are applicable (i.e. no grass courts).
2. Full Tennis members may book a court a maximum of SEVEN DAYS in advance. Restricted and other Tennis members may book a court a maximum of FIVE DAYS in advance.
3. Court bookings must be recorded in the folder located inside the clubhouse entrance.
4. The booking fee is £6.00 per court per session of 90 minutes.
5. The booking fee is due even if players do not show, unless weather prevents play. It is the responsibility of the person who booked the court to pay the fee to the office if necessary.
6. Successive sessions in one evening (i.e. 3 hours) may not be booked by the same set of players in advance. However if, on the evening of play, a court is unbooked for an adjacent session, it can then be consecutively booked.
7. Members violating bye-laws may have their booking taken by other members.
8. The normal Tennis Bye-laws apply to all other times and for all other conditions e.g. clothing, shoes, visitors etc.

N.B.

- The lights are set to switch off automatically at 9.30pm, regardless of how much money is in the meters
- The floodlight meters are situated in the corridor on the squash court wall opposite the booking sheets and accept £1 coins.
- The lights take about 4 minutes to reach full brilliance from cold.
- The lights give at least 4 extra minutes for the £6 fee per 90 minutes. So coins can be inserted in advance of the session start to allow for lights warming up.
- If the lights are allowed to switch off they will not relight for about 5 minutes to protect the bulbs. So please try to avoid this practice to preserve the lights and to be considerate to other club members.
